

COURSE TITLE: British Sign Language – Level 1

DESCRIPTION OF THE COURSE;

Students will study 3 different units throughout the course. Once the 3 units have been completed and successfully assessed students will be awarded with a Signature (CACDP) accredited certificate in British Sign Language. The units are:

- Introduction to British Sign Language (BSL)
- Conversational Skills – Production and Receptive
- British Sign Language – At school/ college/ work

WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS?

There are no formal entry requirements only enthusiasm and an appetite for learning. However, we will only accept students aged under 18 if accompanied by a parent/guardian/other student aged 18 or over.

WHO IS THE COURSE FOR?

This course is designed for those who wish to develop their knowledge and understanding to help meet the needs of deaf people in either social, vocational or professional situations.

WHEN IS THE COURSE?

HOW LONG IS THE COURSE?

45 Guided Learning Hours (GLH) – ie: classroom teaching time, including assessments.

10 Additional Study Hours – private study, homework, practice

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

Assessment for this qualification has 3 assessments in total – 1 assessment at the end of each module undertaken by the course tutor. All assessments are practical and will be recorded onto video/DVD.

Any re-sit of assessments is chargeable to the student.

WHAT QUALIFICATION WILL I RECEIVE?

You will be awarded a certificate in British Sign Language - Level 1 upon successfully completing the practical assessments.

ONCE COMPLETED, HOW CAN I PROGRESS?

Once the course has been successfully completed, students are able to progress onto BSL Level 2 or Communication Tactics with Deaf and Deaf/blind people T101 or Deaf Awareness K101.
